In the Buffalo area in 2007, Klein purchased and moved into the former Gibraltar Industries Inc. metal processing facility on Military Road from its previous processing and distribution center in Blasdell.

Founded in 1971, Klein Steel Service is a Rochester Top 100 company with more than 360,000-square-feet of facilities.

The company provides more than 3,200 line items of stock size metals and a range of value-added processing services.
