

## Threshold Klein Steel

Rochester, N.Y.

The eight-story steel structure located at Klein Steel Service Inc., Rochester, N.Y., was designed by Albert Paley, an American metal sculptor best known for his large-scale exterior installations. The vibrant yellow components that make up Threshold are leftover pieces from Klein Steel Service and Paley's last joint project: Animals Always, a forged, formed and fabricated steel archway constructed for the St. Louis Zoo in 2006. Upon closer inspection, it's easy to see the remnants of animals and foliage in the otherwise geometric lines of the piece. Klein Steel Service performed a majority of the plasma cutting for Animals Always.
